Computing Policy

The most common points of conflict with the policy involve:
 - Using College and University mailing lists to broadcast announcements – Instead, undergraduates should e-mail firsteam@oregonstate.edu to get announcements into the weekly student bulletin.
 - Storing and using non-work-related media files on the network.
 - Storing files in public disk spaces that could be considered obscene, offensive, or threatening.
 - Viewing potentially obscene, offensive, or threatening files or Web pages in public spaces where your computing screen may be viewed by other people.
 - Storing and using peer-to-peer file sharing programs.
- **GUIDELINES FOR USAGE** have been established. Use of all facilities is expected to conform to the College of Forestry Code of Professional Conduct. See <http://studentservices.forestry.oregonstate.edu/college-forestry-code-professional-conduct>

User Accounts & Services

- **ONID ACCOUNTS:** To set up an account, go to <http://onid.oregonstate.edu>
 - An ONID account is needed to logon to the computers in the PVY and RH computer labs. This account will provide you with e-mail, disk space, web space, and other services.
 - Campus wireless network access, use of Blackboard, and class e-mail lists are examples of other services that require an ONID account.
- **PRINTING** is available to all ONID users in the computer labs. Printers are located at the Forestry Helpdesk (PVY 222), Richardson Hall Rooms 123 and 203, and the Self Learning Center (PVY 254). ONID users will be charged for all printing. Current prices are 5 cents/page for B&W printing and 35 cents/page for color printing. A small discount is given when printing to both sides of the paper (duplex printing). See pricing details at: <http://helpdesk.forestry.oregonstate.edu/onid-services-and-printing-policies>.
- **REMOTE ACCESS** to shared files and folders on the Forestry network is available. Students can either make an OSU VPN network connection, login with their ONID account, and access the appropriate server or they can use a software program like WinSCP to gain remote access. - **VIRTUAL COMPUTING LAB** offered by Student Computing Facilities (SCF) allows access to popular software titles as well as your ONID network files. All SCF Virtual Computing Lab software can be accessed through a shortcut on the desktop of all PVY and RH lab computers. Facilities

- **FORESTRY COMPUTING HELPDESK**
 - **Location:** Peavy Hall 222
 - **Hours:** Mon – Fri 8am–6pm during academic terms; 8am–5pm during term breaks and summer.
- **COMPUTING LABS** are in Peavy Hall (PVY 236, 240, 252, 254) as well as Richardson Hall (RH 123 and 203). These labs are available on a first come, first served basis when no classes, workshops, or seminars are being taught in the lab(s).

- **COMPUTING LAB HOURS** are the same as helpdesk hours above with the following exceptions:
 - After-hours access to PVY 240 is available.

 - The Self Learning Center (SLC) in PVY 252 and SLC West (RH 123) have different hours and they are posted on the door.

PVY 240	Classroom/Open Lab <i>Available to all users with ONID or FORESTY user accounts</i>	29 computers (28 for students); 1 flatbed scanner at instructor computer.
PVY 252	Self Learning Center (SLC) <i>Available to all users with ONID or FORESTY user accounts</i>	15 computers; 1 flatbed scanner.
PVY 254	Lundeen Lab <i>Available to all users with ONID or FORESTY user accounts</i>	7 computers, 1 flatbed scanner with an Auto Document Feeder, and printer. Room is always open.
RH123	SLC West <i>Available to all users with ONID or FORESTY user accounts</i>	5 computers and printer
RH 203	Classroom/Quiet Lab <i>Available to all users with ONID or FORESTY user accounts</i>	19 computers (18 for students) and printer THE QUIET LAB !
